ECE 101 CHILD GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT 60 hours - Diploma or Level 1 Credit

This course focuses on the genetic and environmental factors which influence child growth and development from preconception to age twelve. Students will be introduced to the major theories of child development and their connection to our own theories on human behaviour. Social, physical, language, cognitive/intellectual, and emotional development will be considered during the major stages of growth. Students will study factors affecting development, and the relevance this has for those who work with young children. Special emphasis will be placed on practical application of theoretical knowledge.
